Before the semester officially starts, the university is offering a **Maths Preparatory Course via Zoom**, starting on **August 26**. The course is a good opportunity to refresh your maths skills and make sure that everyone starts the Master's with a similar mathematical foundation.

To help you get started, we've planned some **social events** from Tuesday, **September 1st**, to **Friday, September 4th**. The events are organized together with the bachelor's students and are a great opportunity to get to know your new fellow students, meet new people and make new connections before the semester starts.

Here's what we have planned for you:

On Tuesday, September 1st, you can check out the **Initiative Fair (10:00–14:00)** in the **Ehrenhof** and discover the many student initiatives Mannheim has to offer. Of course, you can also come by our stand and get to know us!

This will be followed by a **pub crawl** in the evening (**19:00**), which will be the perfect opportunity to socialize. The pub crawl is organised by the "Student's Union" (in German: Verfasste Studierendenschaft) and for all new first-year students, regardless of their field of study. The meeting point is in the **Ehrenhof**.



On Wednesday (September 2) we are heading to **Club King Kong at 23:00** – feel free to join us! Tickets can be bought on site.

On Thursday (September 3) at **19:00**, we're having our traditional **pre-drinking** on the “**Mensawiese**”, and afterwards, we're heading to the **legendary Schneckenhof**. Schneckenhof is a famous student party in the courtyard of Mannheim's Baroque Palace, and after just one visit, we promise you, you'll love it just as much as we do.

The tickets cost €4. As a Student Association, we usually receive a limited number of tickets that we are allowed to sell separately from the regular ticket sale. At the moment, we don't know how large our ticket allocation will be. Therefore, we may be able to offer a separate sale, allowing you to skip the long queue. If not, you will need to attend the official ticket sale on Tuesday at the Mensawiese. We'll share all the details in the WhatsApp Group on Sunday evening.

On Friday (September 4) at **18:00**, we've rented a boat together with the law students for a legendary **boat party** on the Neckar. Tickets are subject to availability. More Information's will follow in the WhatsApp-Group chat.
